# DEFAULT FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE WITH DEPENDENT OR MINOR CHILD(REN)

This cause came before this Court for a default final hearing on July 18, 2024, on a Petition for Dissolution of Marriage. The Court, having reviewed the file and heard the testimony, makes these findings of fact and reaches these conclusions of law:

- 1. The Court has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter herein.
- 2. The parties were married on November 25, 2015 in India.
- 3. The parties resided in Florida and New York between 2018 and 2023.
- 4. The Petitioner testified that Respondent left the United States in April of 2021, has not returned and has had no communication.
- 5. Petitioner has resided in St. Johns County, Florida.
- 6. An affidavit of Diligent Search and Proof of Publication has been filed in this case and Respondent did not appear at the final hearing.
- 7. The parties operated a hotel business that was shut down during Covid and has since filed for bankruptcy.
- 8. There are numerous marital debts that Petitioner agreed to keep in his name while Petitioner keeps his retirement in its entirety.
- Each party will keep their respective banking accounts and credit card accounts in their individual names.
- 10. The Petitioner is awarded his 2012 Lincoln MKT.
- 11. Due to the mother's abduction (ipk)of the child, the court finds that it would be detrimental to award Shared Parental Responsibility and awards Petitioner Sole Parental Responsibility.
- 12. Until Respondent presents herself to the Court, Petitioner will have 100% timesharing.

  Respondent's visitation will be at Petitioner's discretion until such time she presents herself to the Court and motions for additional timesharing. A Supervised/Safety-Focused Parenting Plan attached as Exhibit A
- 13. The Court reserves jurisdiction to determine child support.

14. The marriage is irretrievably broken and is hereby dissolved.

15. The Court reserves jurisdiction to modify and enforce this Final Judgment.
